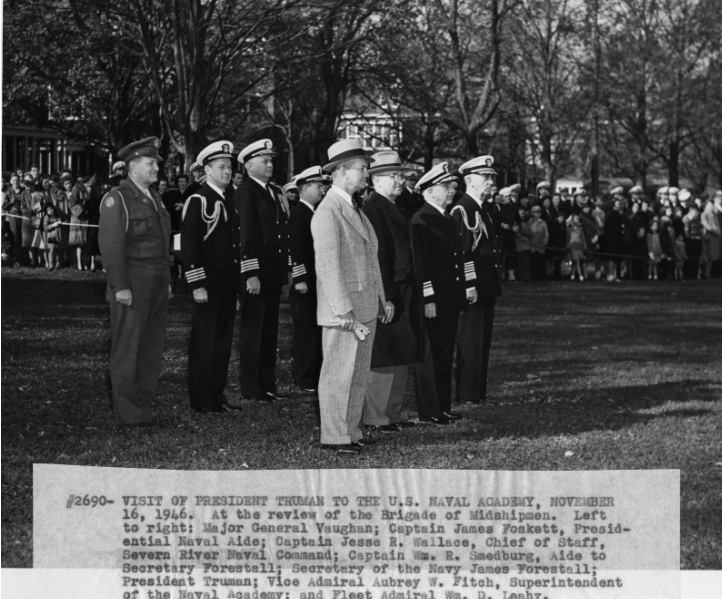


# President Harry S. Truman Visits the Naval Academy
