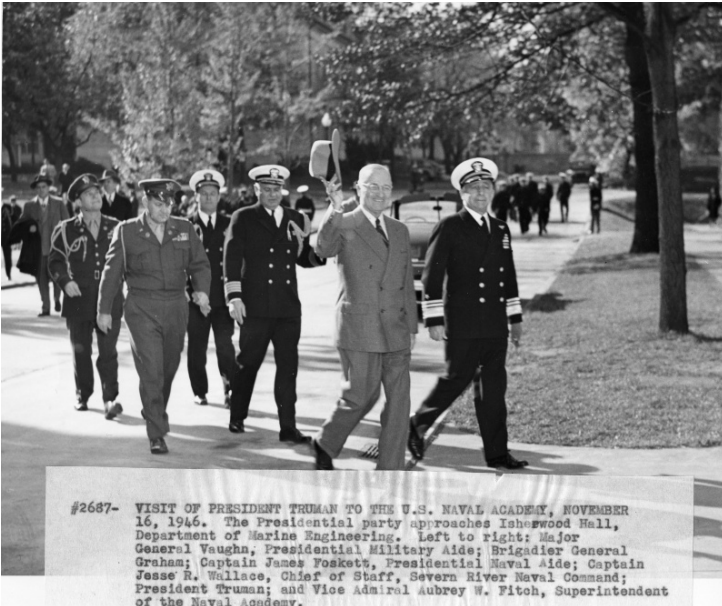


# President Harry S. Truman Walking with Naval Officers
