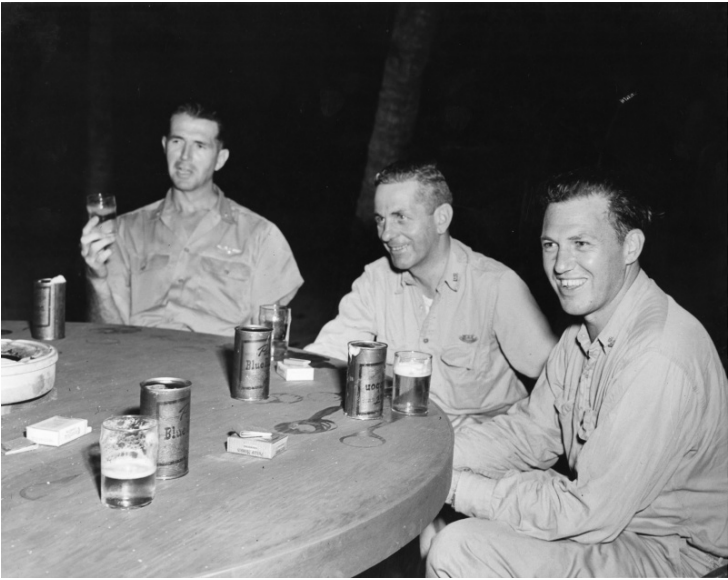


# A Group of Friends at Camp Dealey Enjoy a Beer
