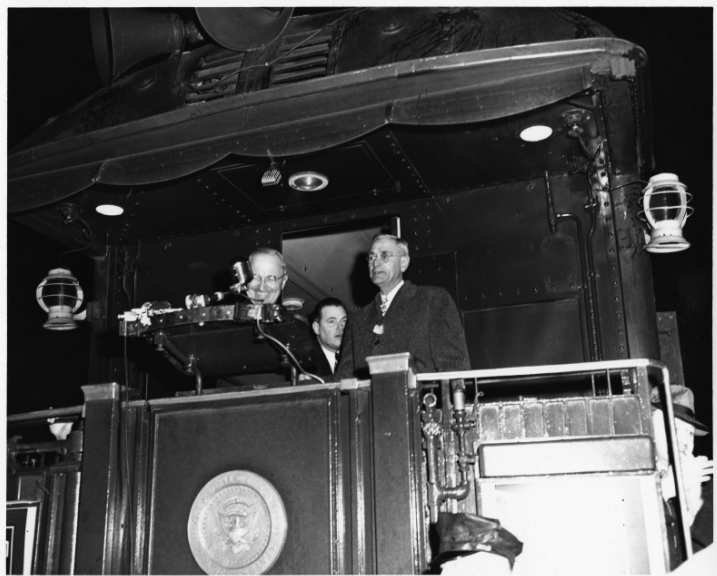


President Harry S. Truman Speaks During Trip Across Nebraska
