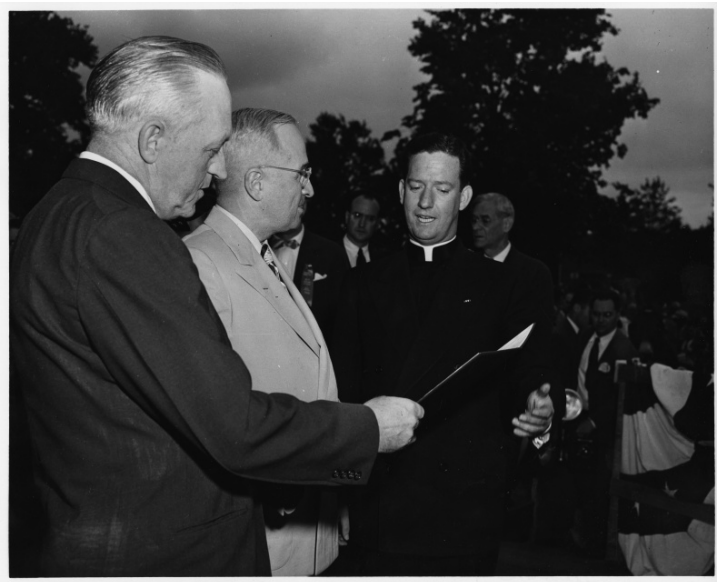


President Harry S. Truman Visits Boys Town
