

# Dr. Edwin G. Nourse Reports to the Cabinet

## **Description**

Dr. Edwin G. Nourse, head of the President's Special Economic Advisory Council, reports to the Cabinet that rationing and price controls are essential to the success of the food conservation program through which the United States is called upon to aid starving Europe.
