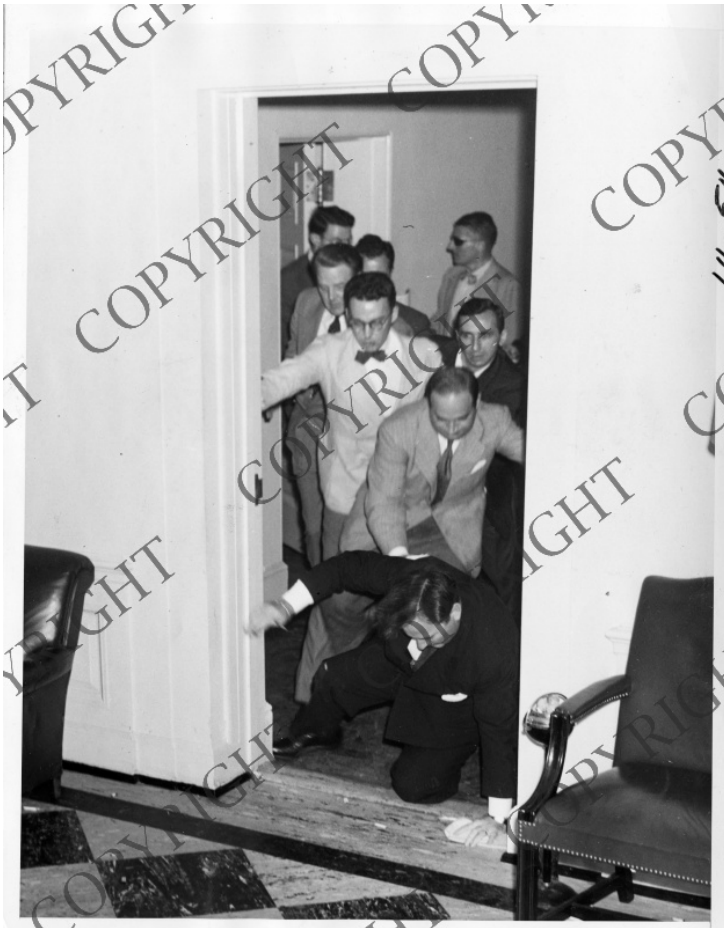


Reporters Scrambling in the White House
