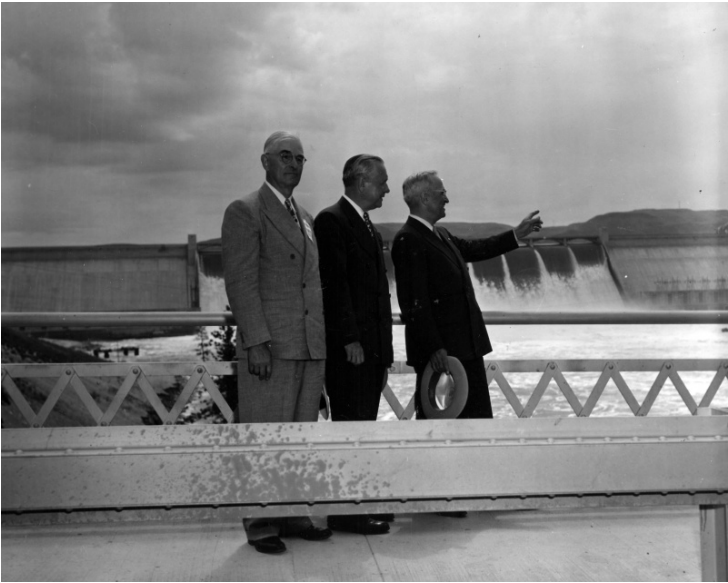


Banks, Wallgren, and Truman at the Grand Coulee Dam
