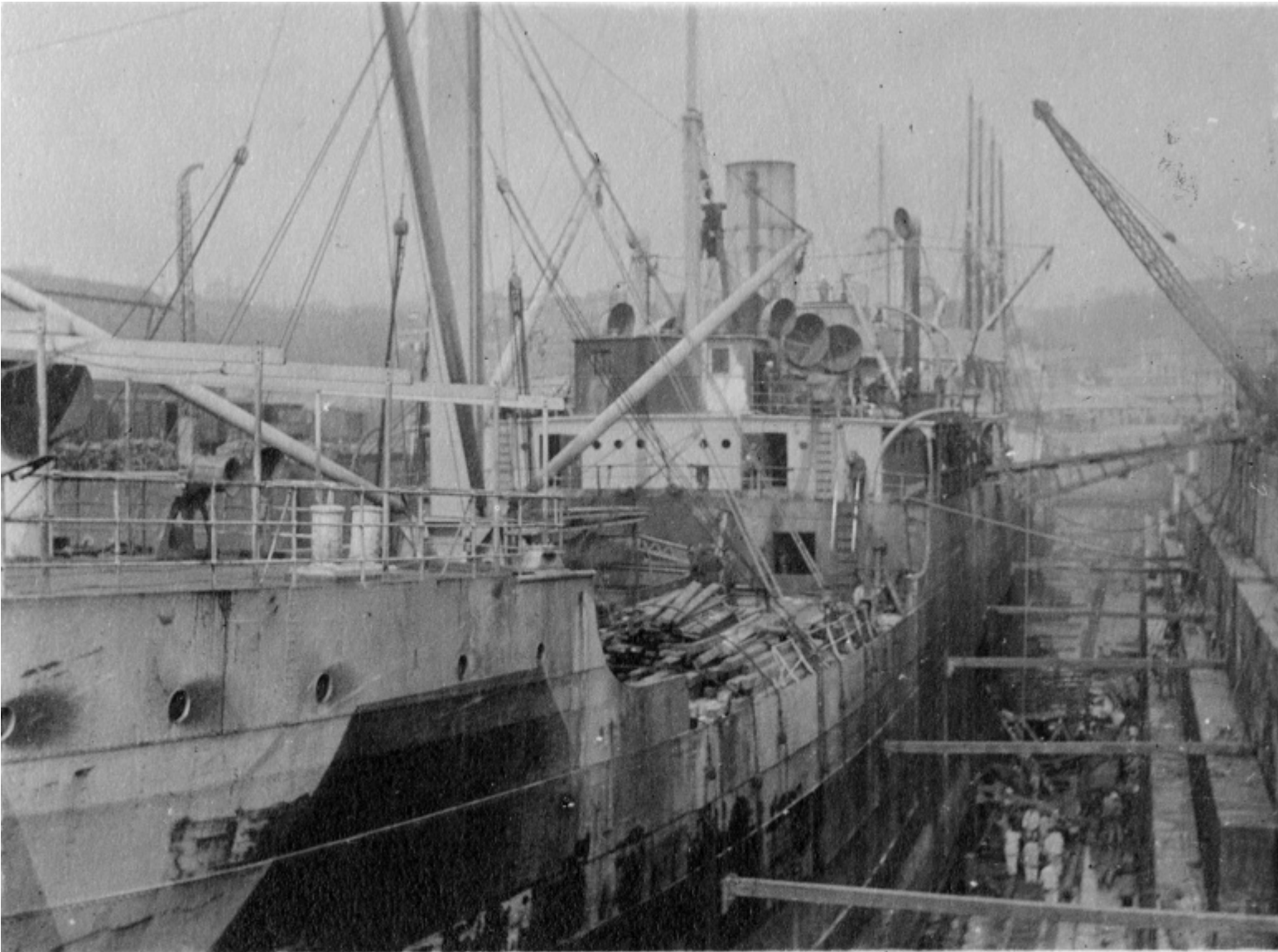


A Ship in Dry Dock at Brest, France After the End of World War I
