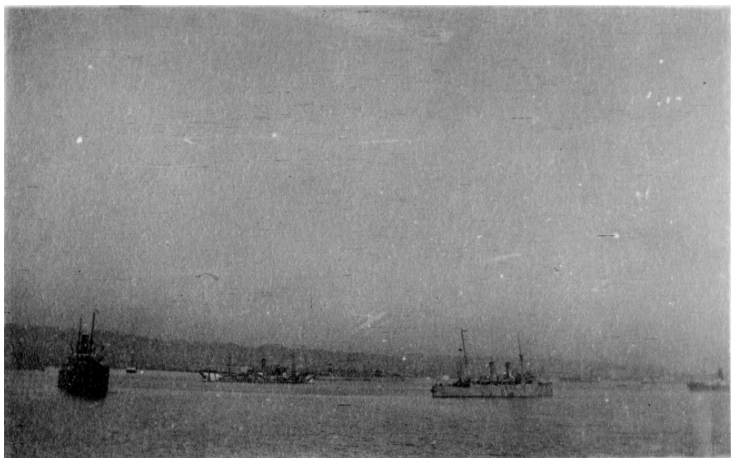


A Group of Ships in a Harbor
