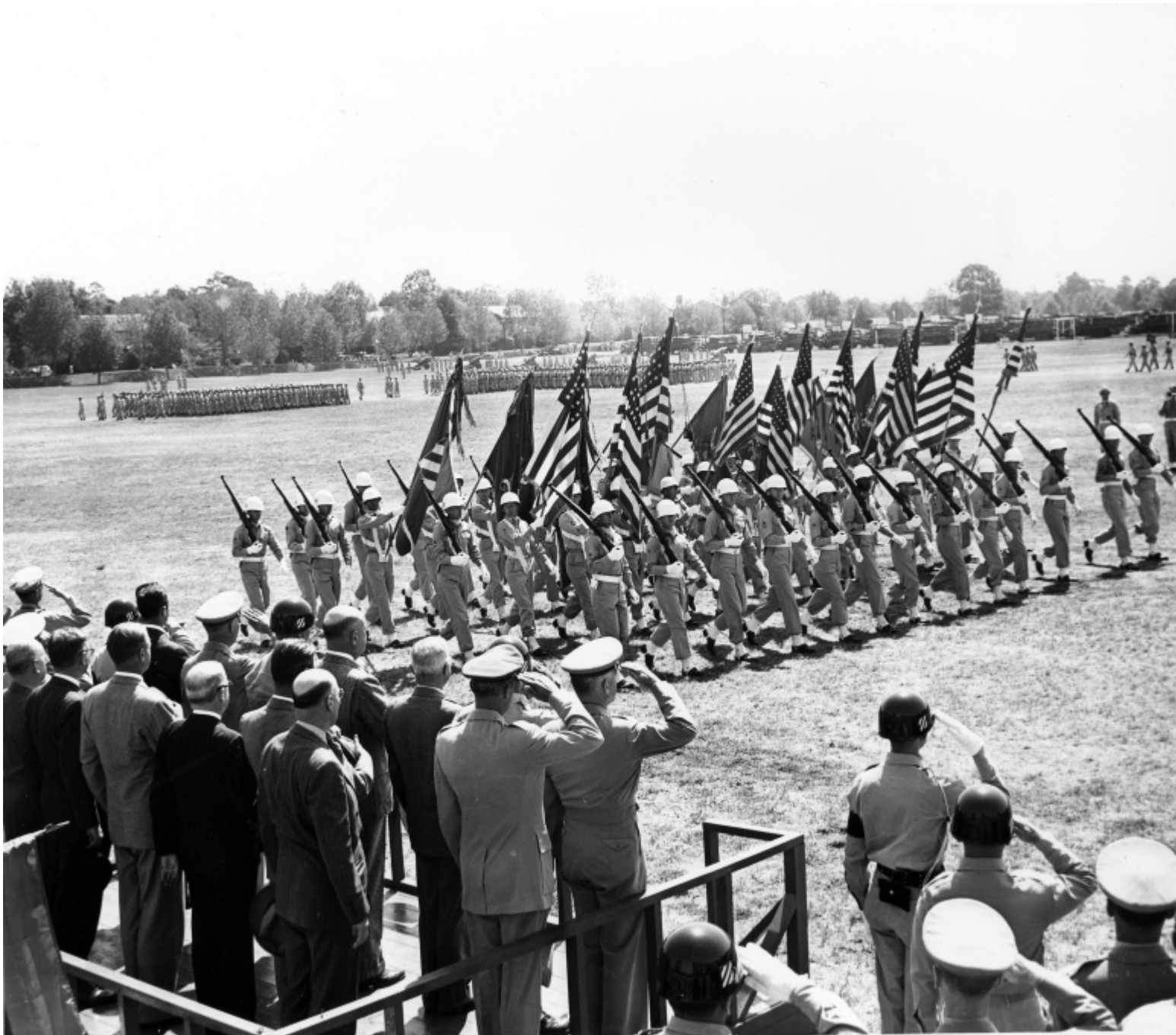


# Presidential Trip to Fort Benning, Georgia
