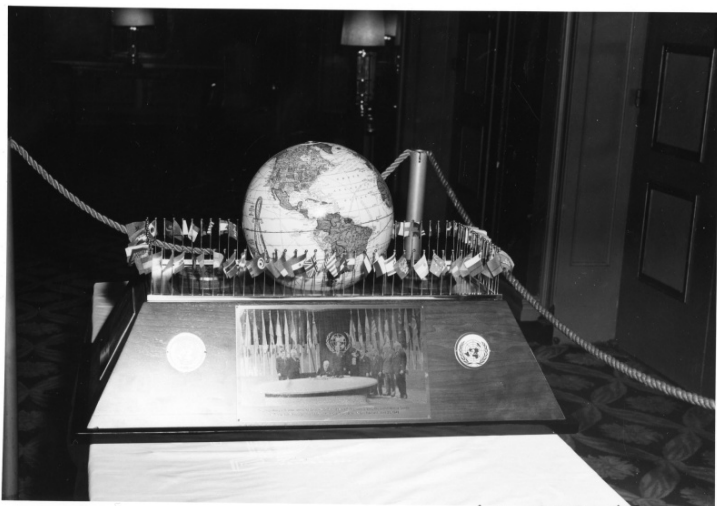


Model of the United Nations
