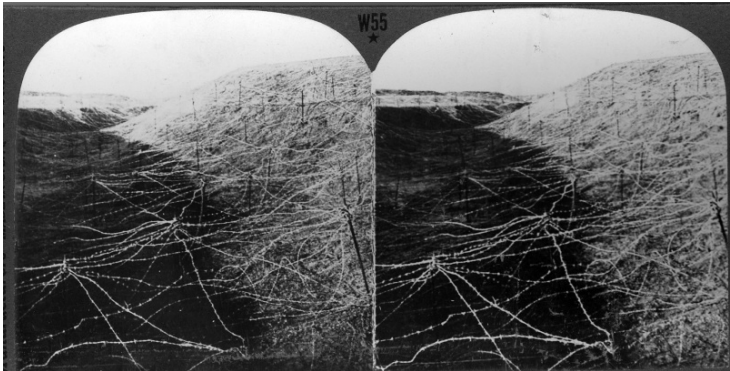


# World War I Stereograph of No Man's Land, Saloniki Front
