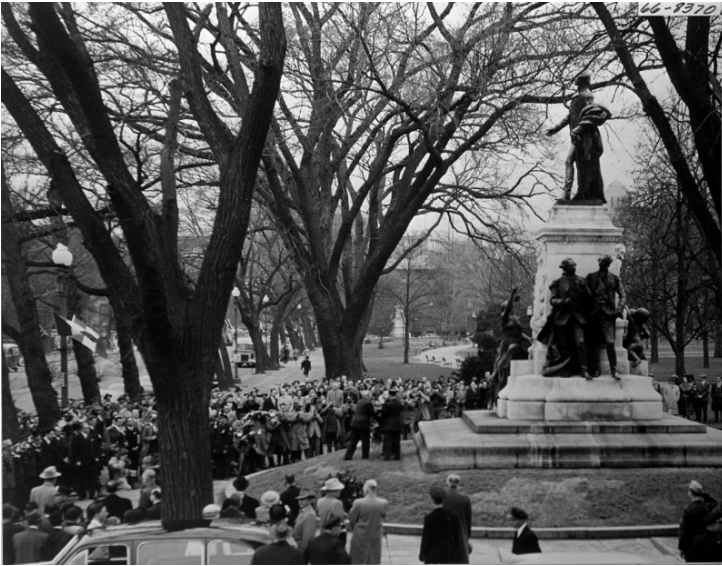


Ceremony at Lafayette Park with French President, Vincent Auriol
