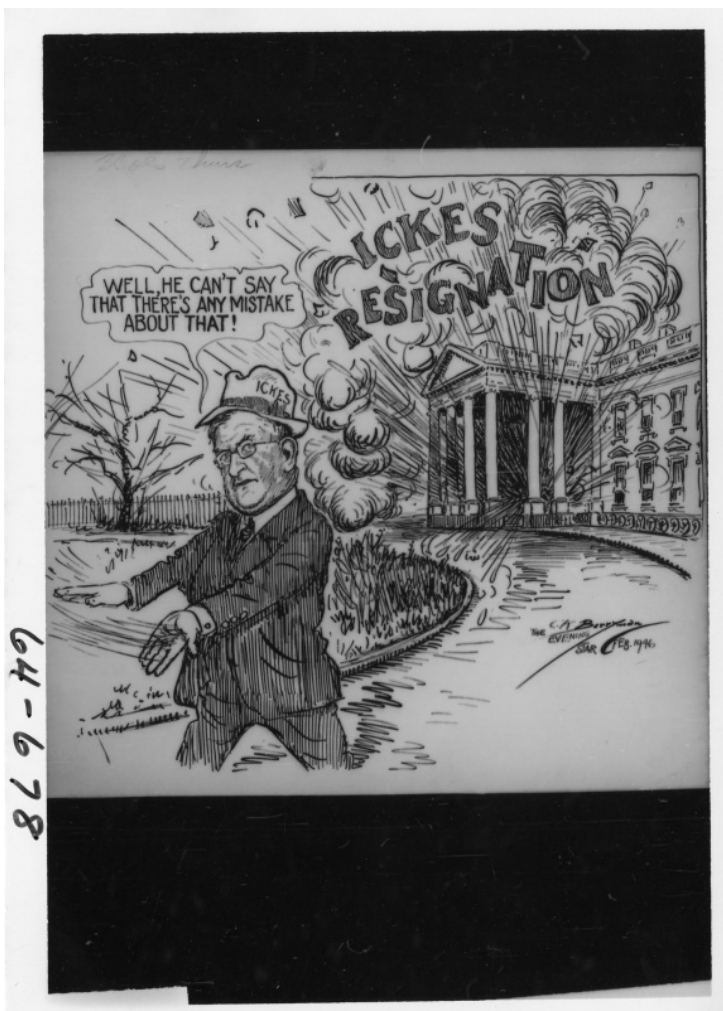


Political Cartoon by Clifford Berryman
