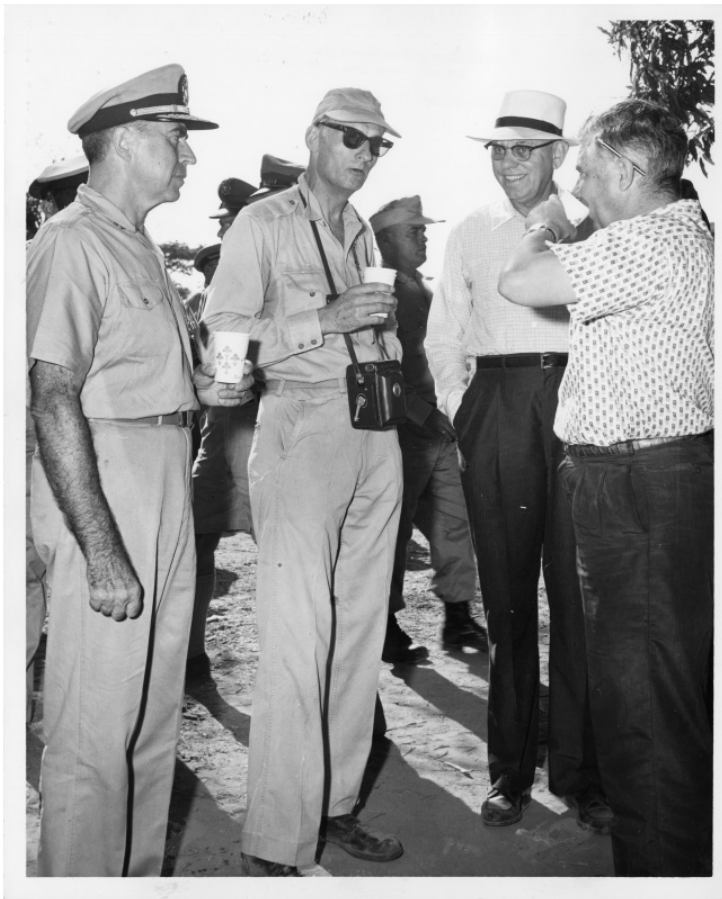


Rear Admiral Lewis S. Parks and Spectators at Banyan Tree II
