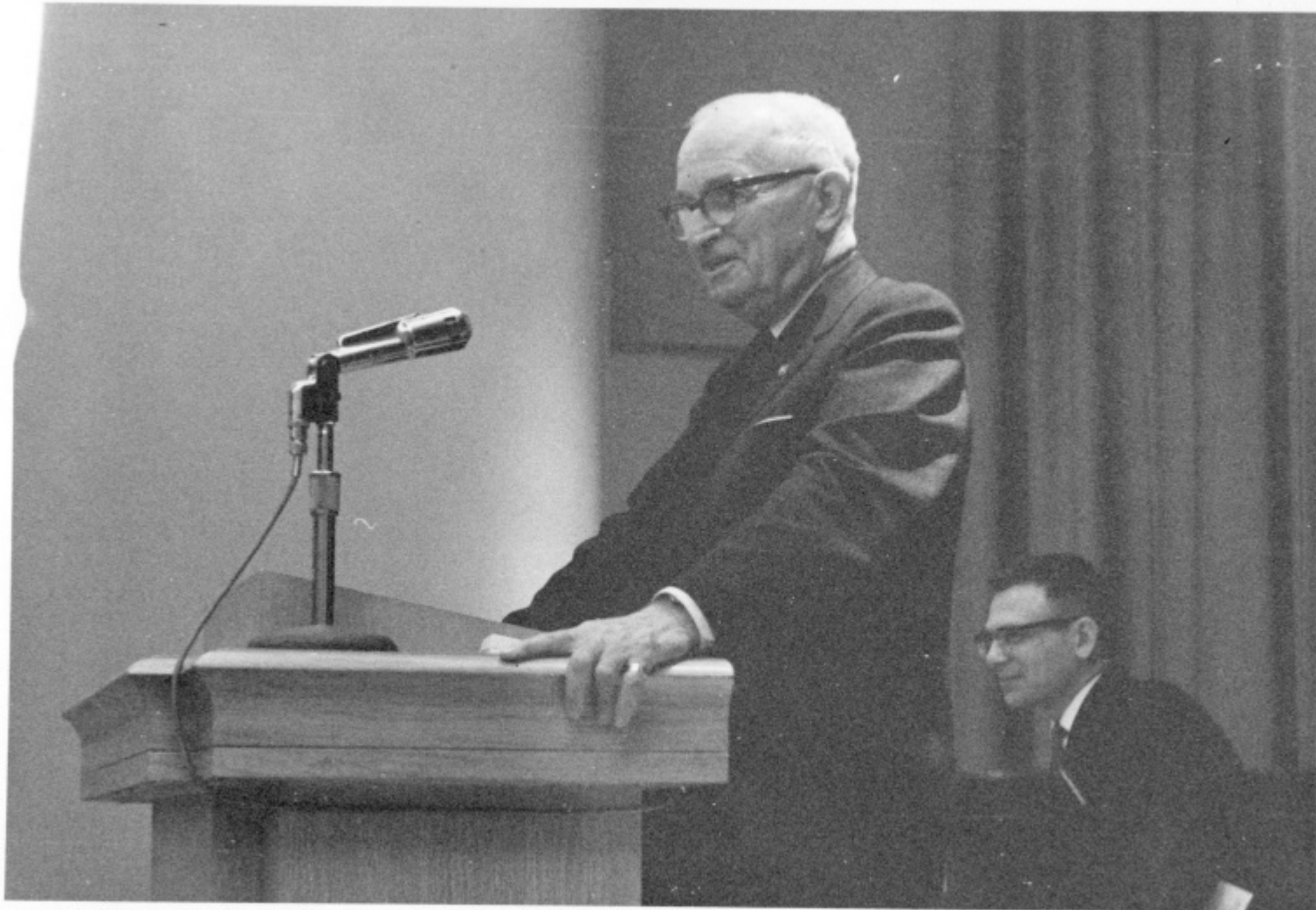


# Former President Harry S. Truman Giving a Speech
