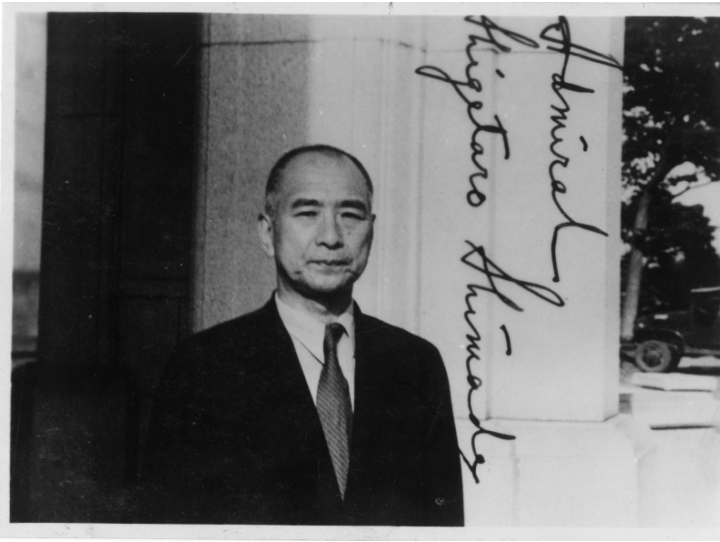


Admiral Shigetaro Shimada
