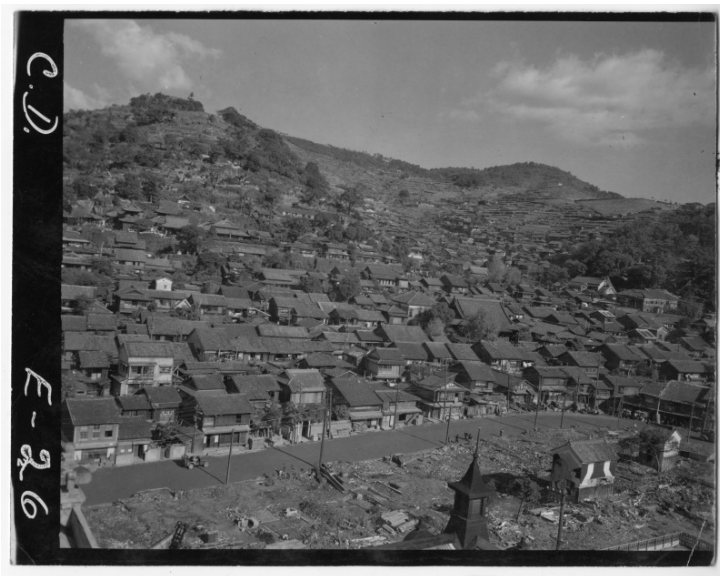


# Residential Area of Nagasaki, Japan Sheltered by the Hills
