

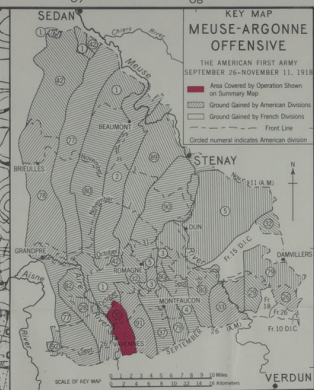

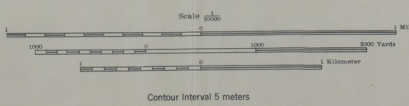

Dates on frontlines indicate dates when boundaries were actually in force. See accompanying Summary of Operations for dates when boundaries were ordered. Lines include results of research of the American Battle Monuments Commission to 1937.
