A French map that is numbered 63 in a series and titled "Vannes-Angers." Annotations, in black ink, presumably show the movement of James Monteith's 128th Field Artillery. Two lines beginning near Ploermel and Rennes lead through Nantes to Angers. Another line, near the top right corner of the map, stretches through Laval. Donated by James K. Monteith.
