

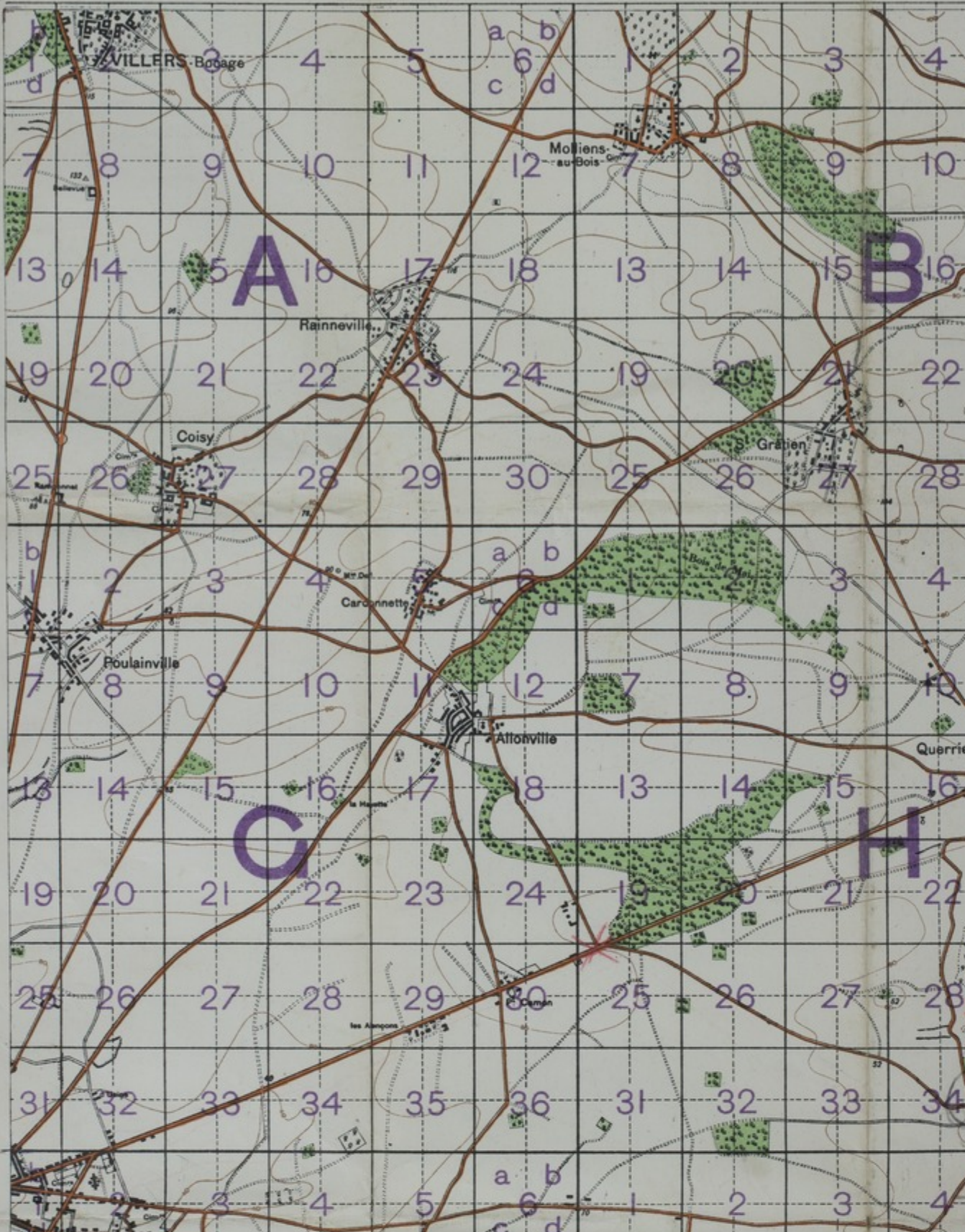

## **Description**
