The map of the Pacific theater shows railroads, rivers, international boundaries, and points of Allied and Japanese activity near Myitkyina, Burma, Hengyang, China, the Volcano Islands, the Bonin Islands, Saipan, Marianas Islands, Noemfoor Island, and Palau, Yap, and Truk of the Caroline Islands.
