

THE BATTLE FRONTS OF EUROPE



In this map are shown drawn to scale upon a map of the UNITED STATES, the battle fronts which the ALLIES were holding in Europe. It will be seen that the total battle front amounts to 2195 miles - a distance only 95 miles less than that from Chicago to San Francisco, while the battle front in the West is nearly half the distance from New York to Chicago.
